- 3 (-6) shelters open; 100 (+24) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Report, 13 Dec)




Open Field Offices as of Dec 13






National Weather Forecast






Active Watches/Warnings


River Forecast






Convective Outlook, Days 1-3





