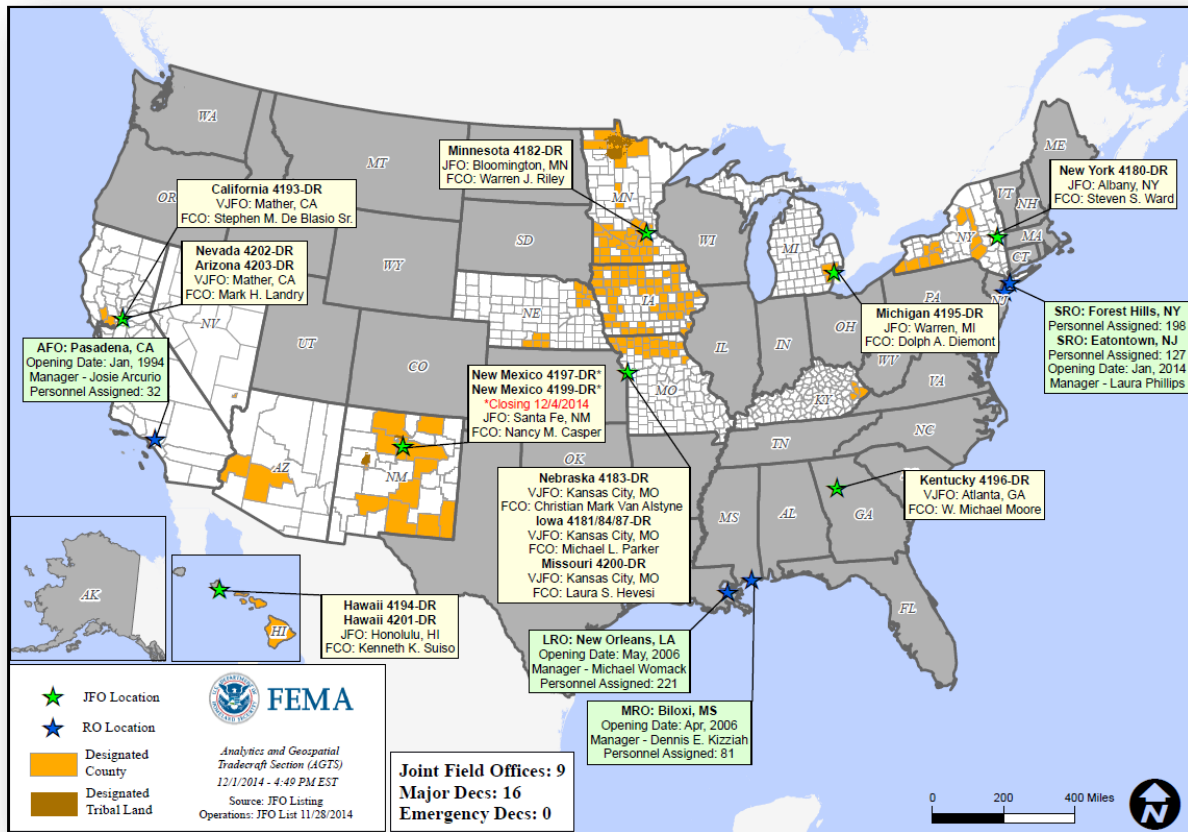

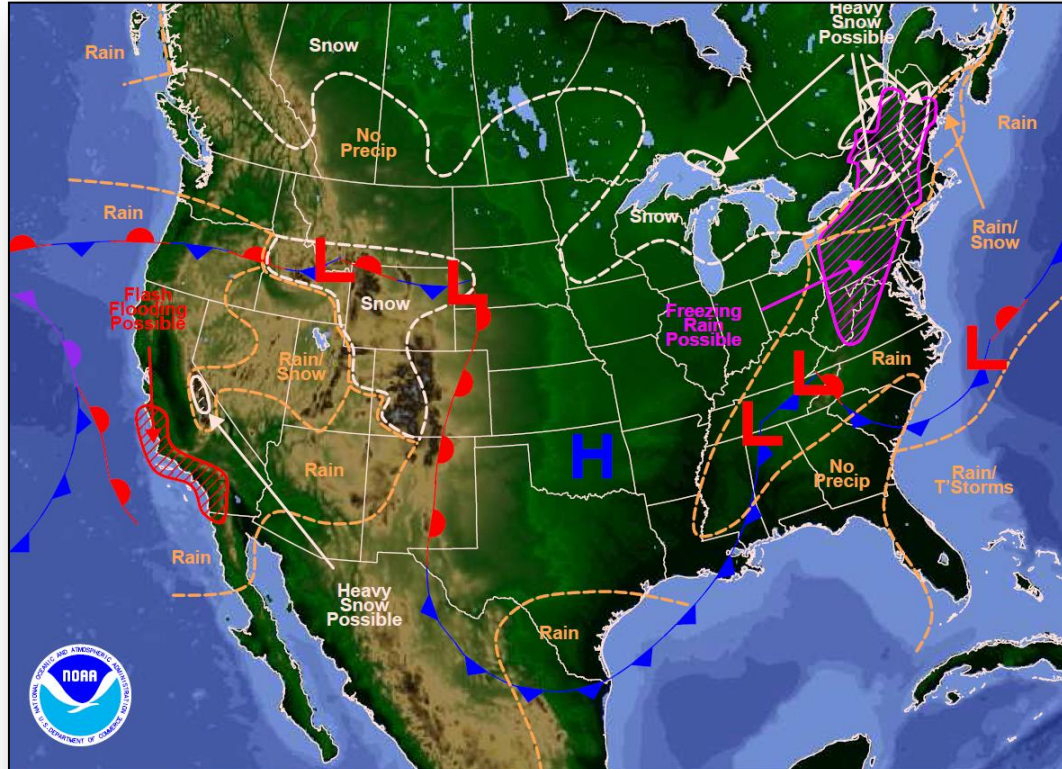

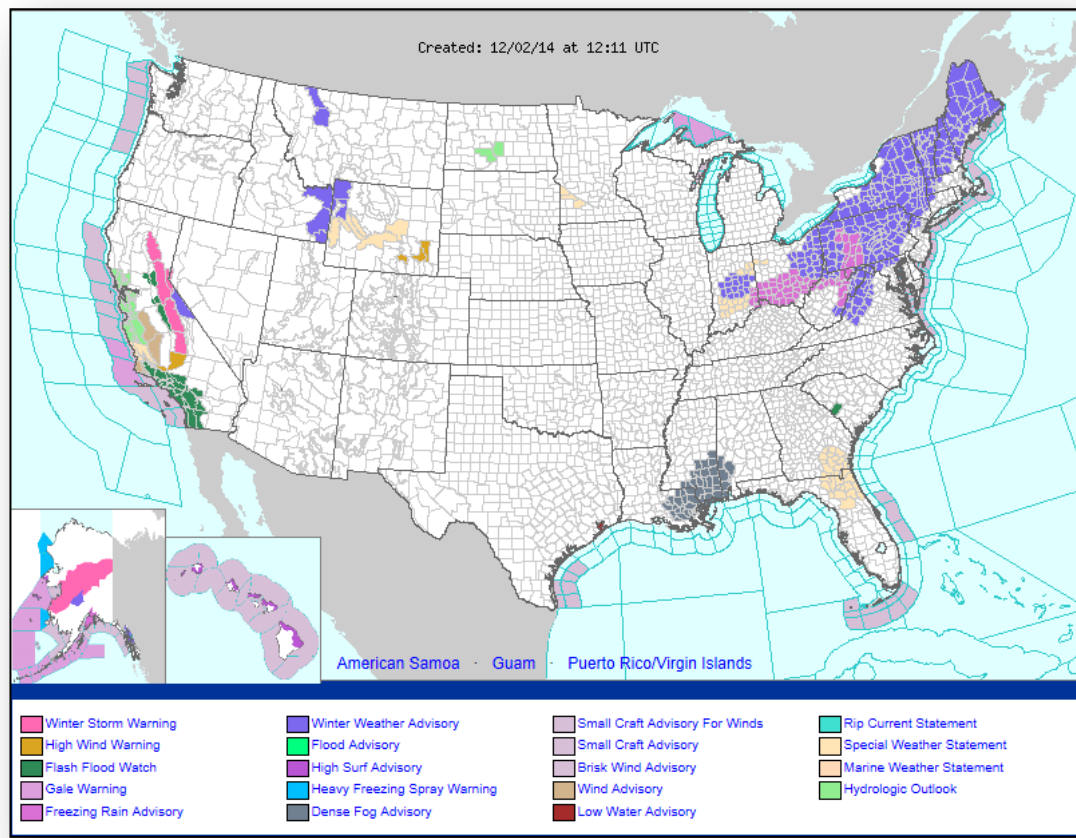

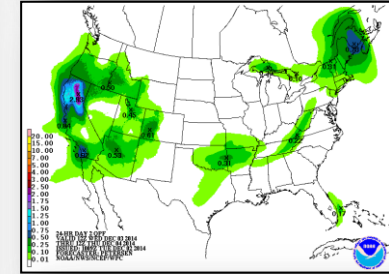

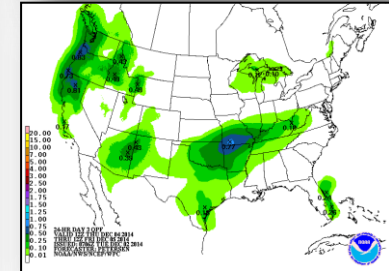
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day

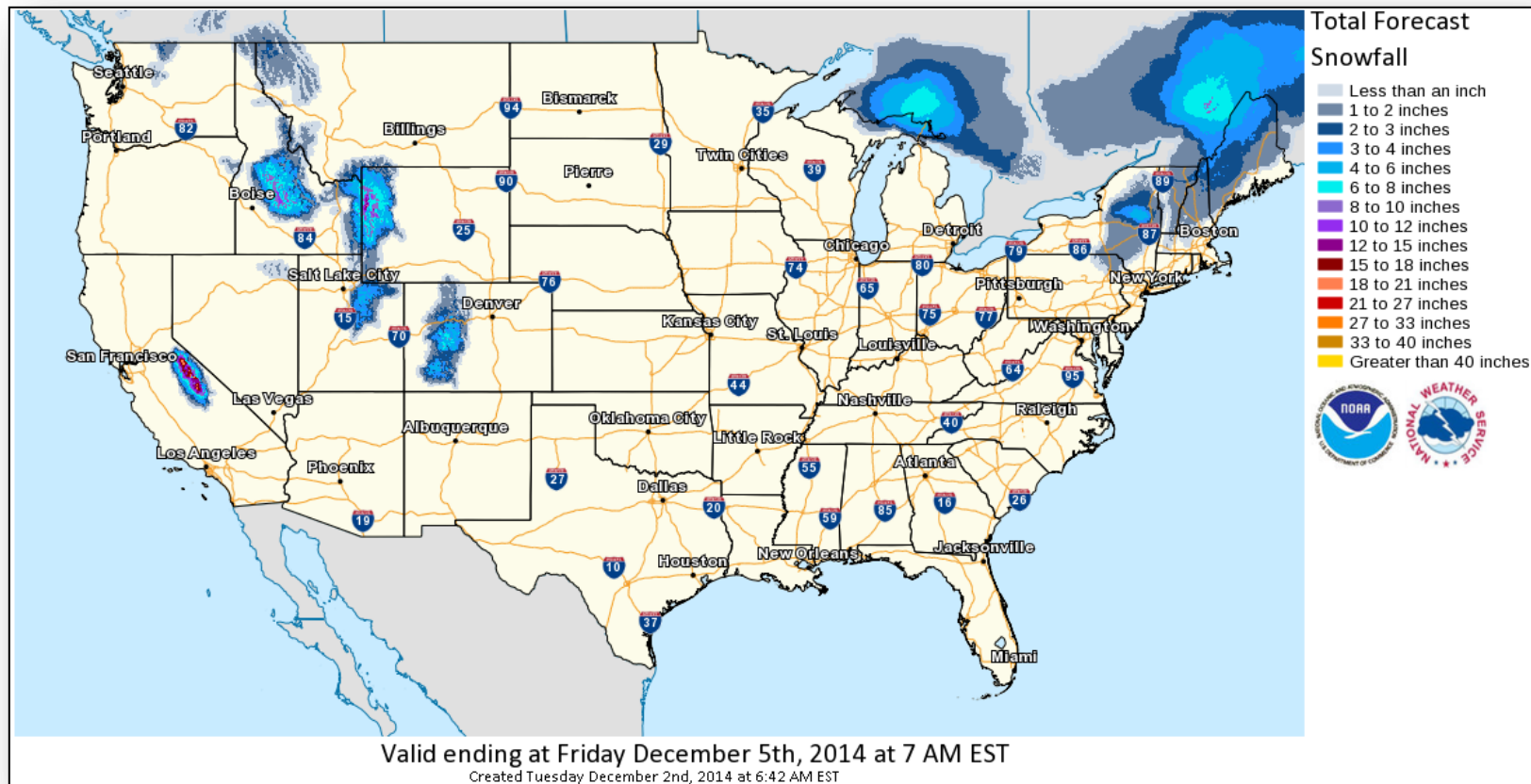

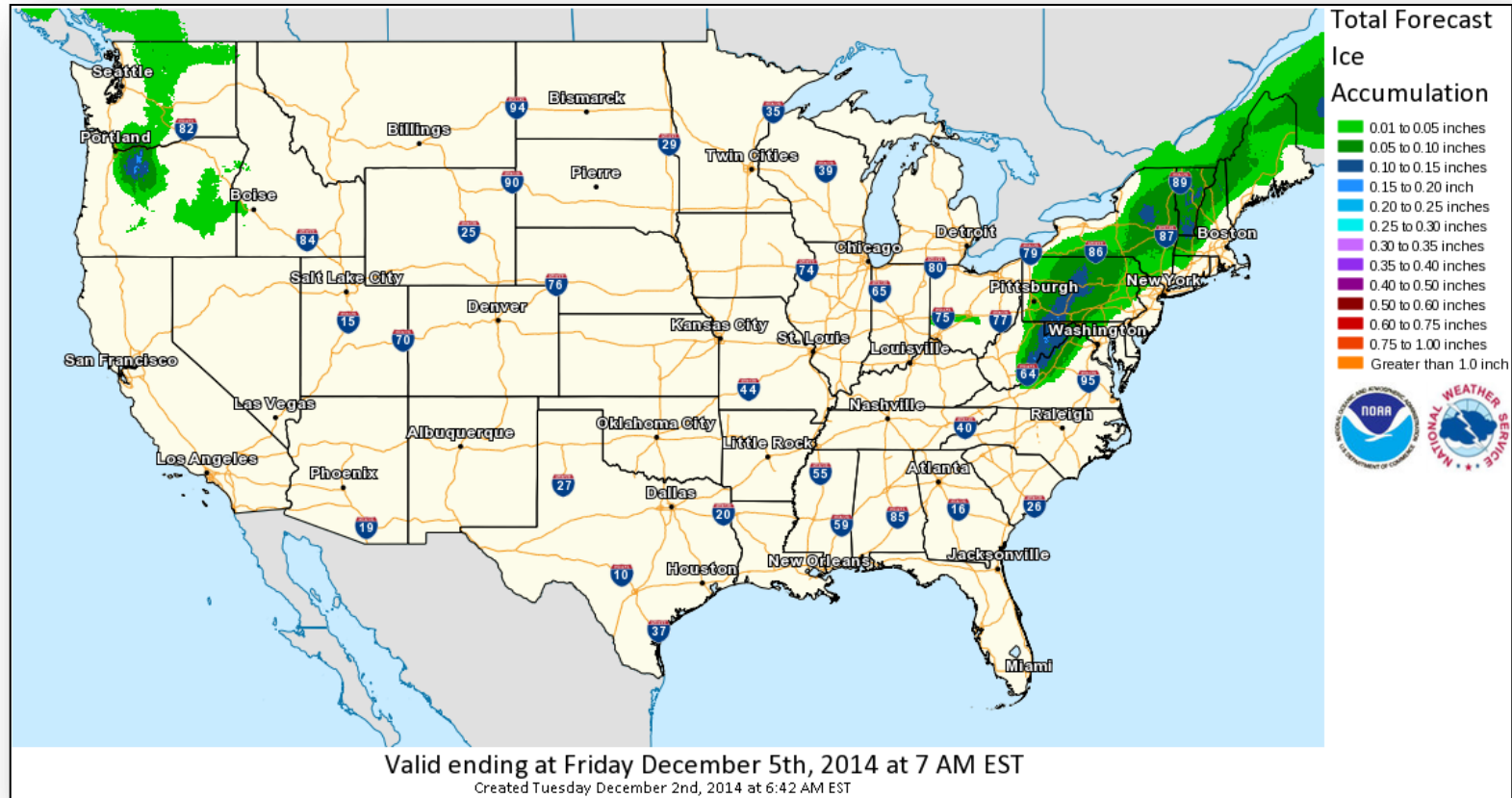

Total Forecast Snowfall



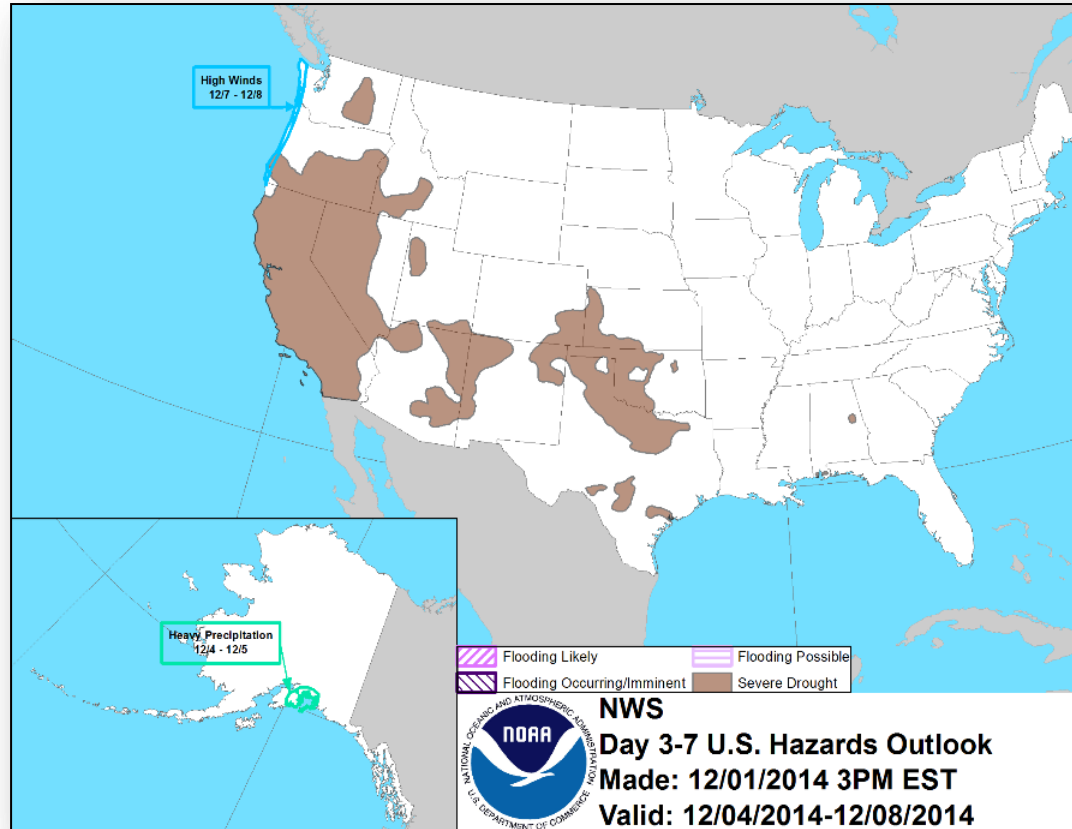
Total Forecast Ice Accumulation

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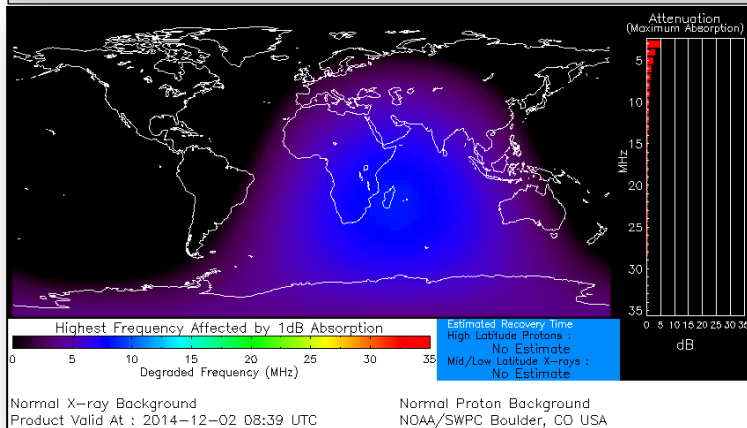

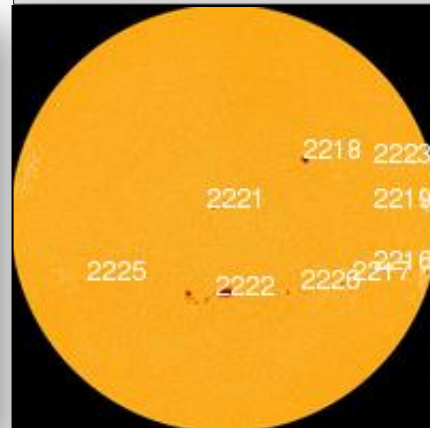

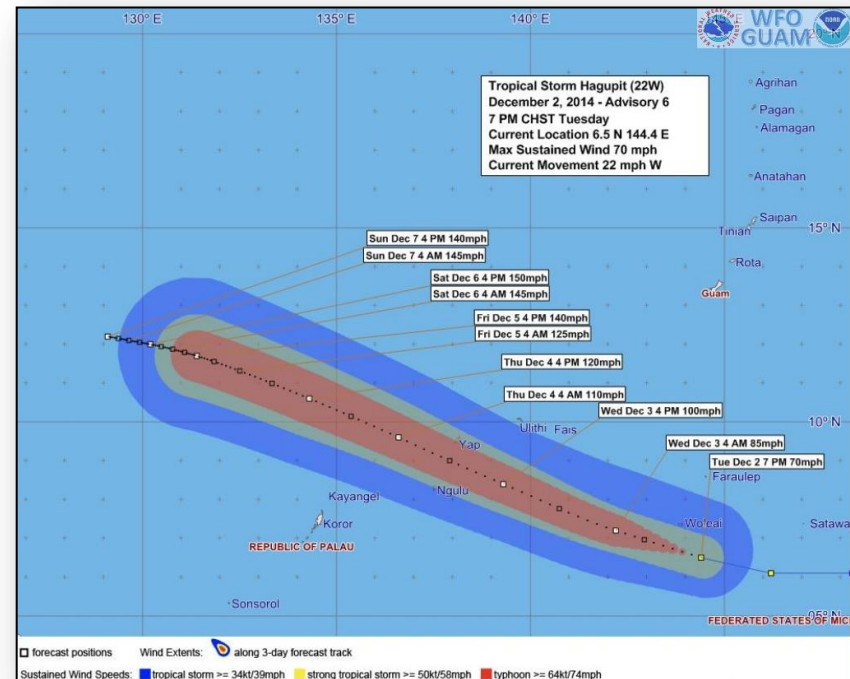
- Located 440 ESE of Yap (515 mi S of Guam)
- Moving W at 22 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 70 mph
- Tropical Storm force winds extend outward 110 miles
- Expected to intensify — could become a typhoon in the next few hours

- Typhoon Watches or Warnings for multiple Islands in Yap State (Federated States of Micronesia*)
- High Surf Advisory in effect for Guam
- **No coastal Watches or Warnings for Guam or CNMI**

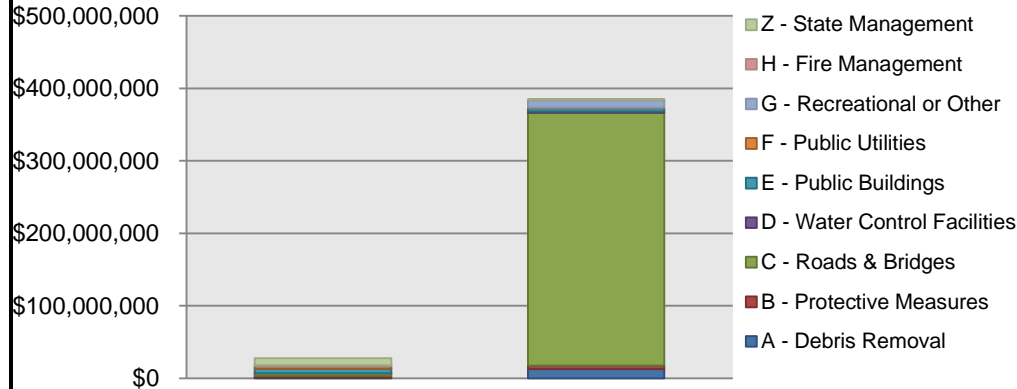

PA Highlights

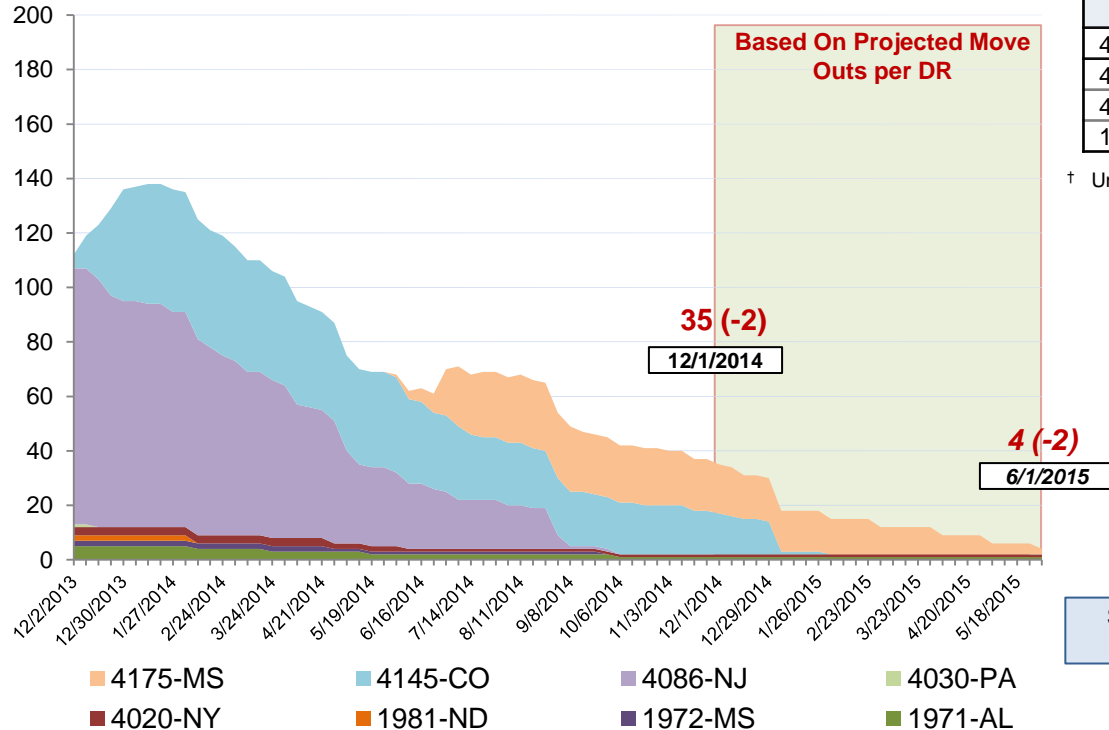

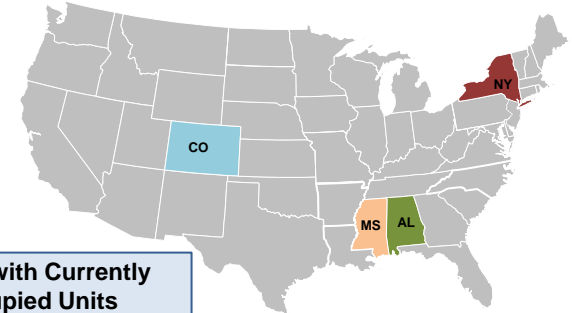
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Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State

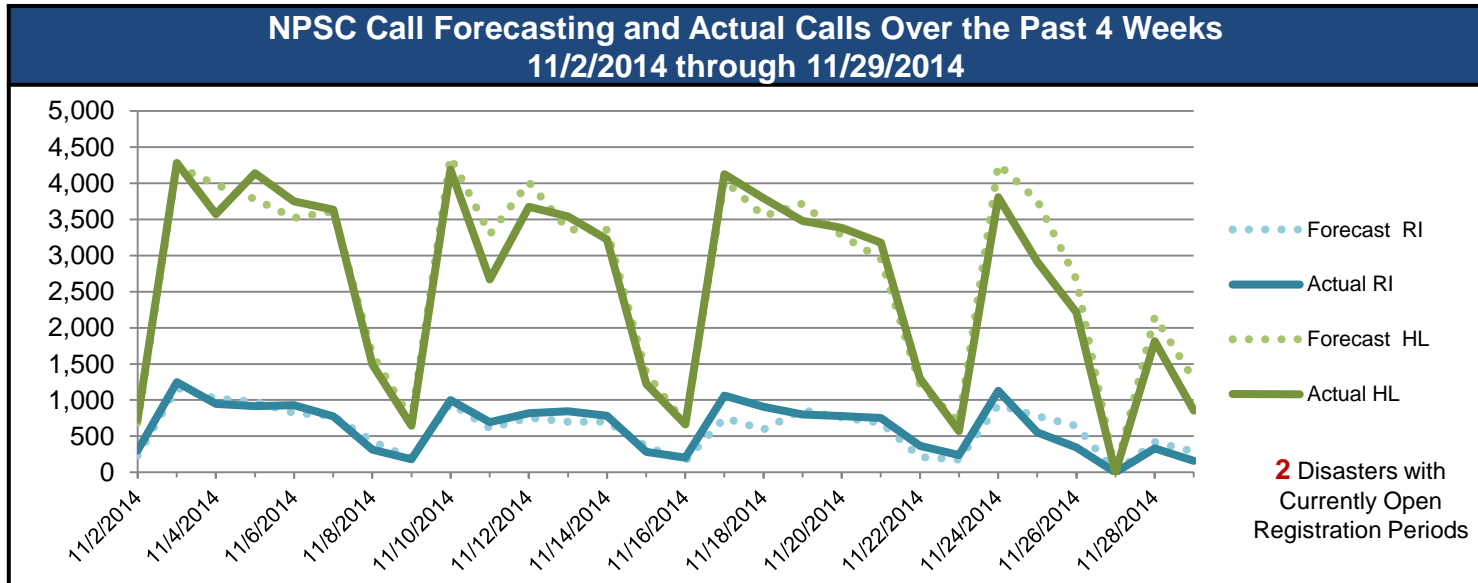
States with Currently Occupied Units

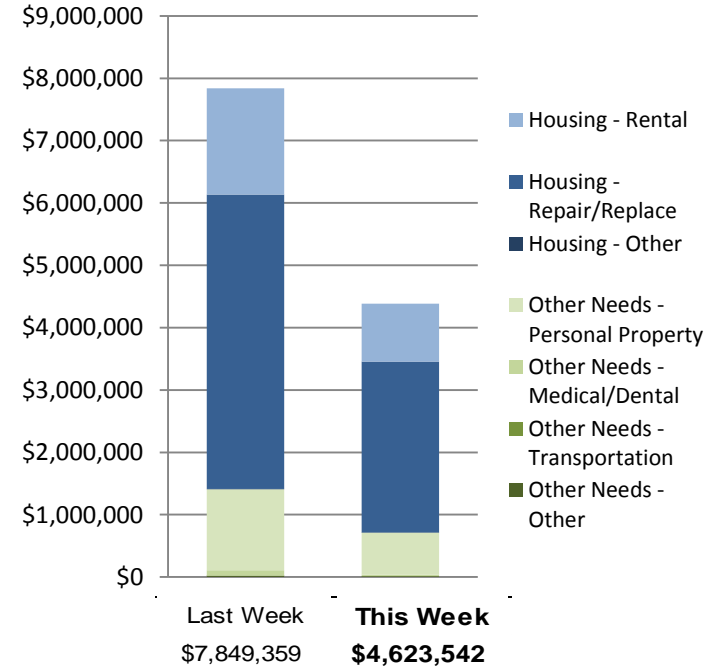
